### **Scoring:**

- Each correct answer will be awarded 10 points.
- There will be 10 paddle questions and 10 written questions for a possible total of 200 points per individual quizzer.
- Highest Honors for a perfect score in either the paddle or written category will be awarded 5 bonus points each.
- Championship quizzers with a perfect score in both categories are awarded an additional 5 bonus points for a total of 15 bonus points.
- The highest possible individual score is 215 points.
- Team scores will be formed from the top 3 individual scores on each team.
- The highest possible team score is 645 points.
- Ties between teams will be broken using the bonus question on the written test.

### **Awards:**

- Team awards consist of a team plaque and individual medallions for 1<sup>st</sup> place and individual ribbons for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place team members.
- Quizzers that get a perfect 10 out of 10 score in either the paddle or the written portion of the quiz will be awarded a Highest Honors ribbon. (2 possible ribbons)
- Quizzers that get a perfect 10 out of 10 score in both the paddle and the written portion of the quiz will get a Championship ribbon.
- It is possible for a quiz participant to get as many as 4 awards: a team medallion or ribbon, 2 Highest Honor ribbons and a Championship ribbon.

### **Important Information:**

- Quiz questions may cover the following in Discoveries/Challenges 1 - 6:
  - Questions and Answers
  - Memory Verses
  - Word Wise words and definitions
  - Search Sites
- The Book One Quiz may also include material from the Start Zone.
- The paddle questions will be non-version specific.
- The written tests will be available in all three versions and cover version specific questions such as filling in the missing words in a Bible verse.
- Every written test will include an optional 11<sup>th</sup> bonus question to be used only in the case of a tie.
- Each quizzer must quiz from their current handbook. No quizzer may quiz out of a book for more than one year.
- Quizzers and leaders participating as coaches must wear Awana uniforms.
- Have at check-in the name of each quizzer and what handbook/Bible version they use.
- Have at check-in the name of each quiz coach and the number of years they have coached so they can receive their service pin.
- Each participating church is requested to provide at least 2 scorekeepers.
- Registration Deadline: Your registration should be postmarked no later than one week before the Quiz. See the registration form for the exact deadline for each location.
- Teams will be made up of 3 to 4 quizzers; smaller teams are still encouraged and will be combined with quizzers from other churches to form a team of 3 or 4 quizzers.
- Quiz participants may be disqualified for any appearance of cheating.

- A question may be thrown out if the Quizmaster hears the answer from the audience.
- Once the Quiz has begun no further studying of handbooks, Bibles or other materials is allowed.
- Recording of any of the questions used during the Quiz by any means is not permissible.
- Coaches are encouraged to read the *Awana Bible Quizzing Official Rules and Regulation* available to download from this website.
