- **FOR 2010 –**
 - ⇒ Three circles will be used again this year.
 - ⇒ The team titles of “Division 2” and “Division 3” will now be called the following: All Boys Teams (old div. II boys team), All Girls Teams (old div. II girls team) and COED Teams (old division III team). So it would look like this:

| | All Boys or All Girls No Divisions | COED |
|------------------------|---|--|
| Minimum Players | 10 | 10 (5 boys, 5 girls) |
| Maximum Players | 18 | 14 (7 boys, 7 girls) |
| | No more than ½ of team can be 5th/6th graders. | No more than ½ of team can be 5th/6th graders. |

- Requirements for Coaches:
 - Two coaches per team maximum. Sparks teams may be coached by any leader. T&T girl’s team should be coached by women. T&T boy’s team should be coached by men.
 - Each coach must attend a training session every five years. Since 2007 was mandatory training, most coaches will not need to attend a training session until 2012. **NEW** coaches (both Sparks and T&T) need to attend one training session before the event unless they are working with a coach

who has been trained since 2007. Two regional training sessions have been set up for training:

- 11/14 – 10:00 am – Faith Bible Baptist Church in Valley Center
- 11/16 – 7:00 pm – Faith Bible Baptist Church in Valley Center
- Follow all standards as set forth in Official Rules and Regulations. These rules are on the wksawana.org website.
- Must provide one line judge per team. All line judges must attend one of the training sessions.
- **Requirements for Line Judges:**
 - Line Judges may be men or women.
 - Line Judges must be active Awana leaders.
 - **ALL** Line Judges (both Sparks and T&T) supplied by churches on February 6 are required to attend one training sessions (regardless of when they last attended training). Two regional training sessions have been set up for training:
 - 1/30 – 10:00 am – Faith Bible Baptist Church in Valley Center
 - 2/1 – 7:00 pm – Faith Bible Baptist Church in Valley Center
- “in each circle, four trained officials, who are familiar with all events, rules governing each, and how to resolve tie events, tie heats, or tie score, assist the circle director in watching for false starts, broken rules, fallen pins, interference, etc.”
- The Awana Games Coordinator (Jeff Schuessler) may reject any line judge volunteer for any reason. The church would be required to supply another trained judge.
